This may sound like a an example however, the truth is this is based on science, in the early 1970s Researchers analyzed retail shopping behavior with this framework and found significant relationships between emotional states and factors such as time spent in the store, propensity to make a purchase, and satisfaction with the experience (e.g., Sherman and Smith 1987; Dawson, Bloch and Ridgway 1990; Kellaris and Kent 1993; Yalch and Spangenberg 1993).

Woman Fined \$1.9 Million for Downloading 24 Songs

Jessica Thomas-Rasset didn't know how good she had it.

Back in 2007, the Minnesota mother made national headlines as the first person sued by the **RIAA** for copyright infringement to actually take the case to trial (instead of settling out of court), after she was charged with downloading copyrighted songs through the **P2P** network, Kazaa. At the trial's conclusion, Thomas-Rasset was found guilty of illegally downloading 24 songs and was fined \$10,000 for each one, amounting to a total of \$240,000 in damages. But the case was deemed a mistrial by the judge and Thomas-Rasset waited two years for a retrial.

Yesterday, the single mother of four was found guilty again, but this time ordered to pay a **mind-boggling \$80,000 per song** -- \$1.9 million in all.

These prices are for an average comparison and may not reflect the absolute highest or lowest price they are used here to demonstrate the real world cost of buying royalty free music in the market place.

In many circumstances you may find the cost could be in the thousands and thousands of dollars depending on the kind of music you want to license and how you want to use it.

The Main reason that Royalty Free music is becoming so popular is that on many websites posting infringing music will result in damages that are not an acceptable risk for the merchant or the website visitor, it is because of this risk that many websites, are just removing and banning users

and in some cases actually reporting those infringing users to the police or civil authorities. You could literally start a business creating video content and using Royalty free music to sync it together with the video.

At this website, just Seven songs would cost you 213.94 cents not only that but they have so many restrictions on the music it is almost impossible to use it.
